

## QUALIFICATION DESCRIPTION

This qualification reflects the role of workers in a range of community settings and clients' homes, who provide training and support in a manner that empowers people with disabilities to achieve greater levels of independence, self-reliance, community participation and wellbeing. Workers promote a person-centred approach, work without direct supervision and may be required to supervise and/or coordinate a small team.

- Senior Disability Worker

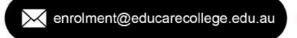
Or

Have completed CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Disability) or similar qualification. Students are required to undertake this training on a full-time basis (20 hours per week plus additional hours for the self-study component of the course simultaneously with face to face study).

# Pre-requisite Academic Requirement

Australian Educare College requires applicants to have completed minimum of Certificate III level qualification in either:

- CHC33015 Individual Support(Ageing)
- CHC33015 Individual Support(Disability)

To maximize students' chance of achieving this qualification, Australian Educare College as an RTO has the following entry requirements which must be satisfied, through verified evidence:

## Age Requirement

Must be minimum 18 years or older Academic Requirement A minimum of Year 12 from home country, English Language Requirements IELTS of 5.5 or an equivalent score

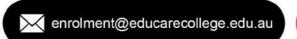
### Work-Placement Requirements

Once graduated students may also consider additional training to complement their individual care skills, with courses such as:

 CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Home and Community) Ideal for providing home care and community services

Graduates of this course might also consider enrolling in CHC43015 Certificate IV in Ageing Support, CHC52015 Diploma of Community Services.

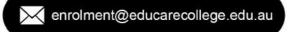
