QUALIFICATION DESCRIPTION

This qualification reflects the role of workers in the community and/or residential setting who follow an individualized plan to provide person-centered support to people who may require support due to ageing, disability or some other reason. Work involves using discretion and judgement in relation to individual support as well as taking responsibility for own outputs. Workers have a range of factual, technical and procedural knowledge, as well as some theoretical knowledge of the concepts and practices required to provide person-centered support.

AEC TARGET CLIENTS

The target group for this course are international students who are new entrants into the care industry and are interested in pursuing positions as:

- Aged care workers
- Aged Care Support Workers

CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Disability) is an entry-level qualification. It is expected that these new entrants are most likely to have none to minimal experience in the field of individual support in public facilities, community services or individual care. They are required to undertake this training on a full-time basis (20 hours per week plus additional hours for the self-study component of the course).

AEC COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To maximize students' chance of achieving this qualification, Australian Educare College as an RTO has the following entry requirements which must be satisfied, through verified evidence:

Must be minimum 18 years or older Academic Requirement A minimum of Year 12 from home country, English Language Requirements IELTS of 5.5 or an equivalent score Physical Requirement Applicants need to have the mental, emotion

Applicants need to have the mental, emotional and physical capability and willingness to work with aged and/or disability clients for extended hours on a daily basis. This will be assessed through the 'Student Enrolment Assessment Interview form'.

Work-Placement Requirements

Students must have a current Police Clearance as well as child clearance prior to starting their work placement.
